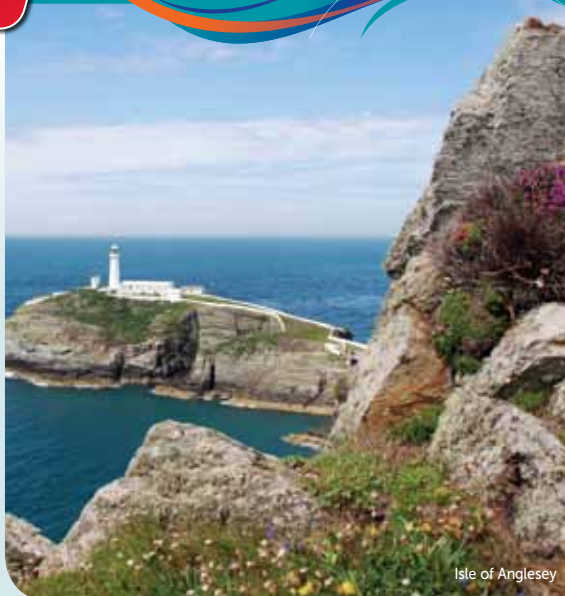
# Isle of Anglesey

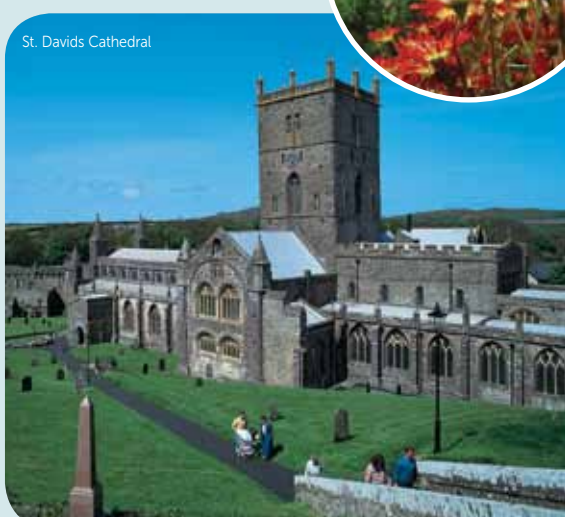
**Itinerary:**
